January 28, 2021

The Kenwood Station Elementary School Council met via Google- Virtual Meeting.

1. The meeting was called to order at 3:01 p.m. Ashley Payne was not in attendance for this meeting. All other board members present.
2. The agenda for this meeting was given to the board members. Motion to approve was made by Abigail Gerst and seconded by Benjamin Murphy.
3. The minutes from the November 19 meeting were given to the board members. Motion to approve by Emilee Shryoock and seconded by Alisa Clay.
4. Council Action Item one - Oldham County Slides regarding SBDM Policy were viewed and discussed. No questions or actions taken.
5. Council Action item two - SBDM report to the Board of Education was discussed. Members were in agreement about the report and expectations for the presentation. All present felt comfortable presenting to the Board of Education meeting February 2nd.
6. Council Discussion Item - Staff Priorities for next Year were presented. Each grade level met and discussed next year's priorities for their teams. That list was used to compile a school list of priorities.
