THE FIRST

The first Tianshi came as a wave underneath in

the ocean. For centuries it had been curled up in its egg, warm and comfortable on top of volcanic vent, not too concerned by its state of being, until a violent current ripped it from its home. With an angry scuffle, it burst out, narrowly avoiding a hungry jellyfish creature as it fought against the wildly swirling water. Snapping its newborn eyes open, it yelled at the ocean with an ear-piercing shriek. The current, who had, perhaps, gotten a bit too wide, was taken aback by the tiny creature's shout. The current seemed to scurry away, leaving the pieces of its shell upon the sandy coral below.

The Tiánshí, also known as Cream Girls (female) and Baker Boys (male) are delightful, lithe kemonomimi-like creatures that enjoy cooking! Armed with magic to create all kinds of goods, they are always zipping preparing something. They love preparing delicious food to eat, and are always making sure to give it their all when they cook.

Some have wings, but they all have long, thin tails that can help either glide through their air, swim through the water, or balance on to get something on a high shelf. They also have a wide variety of ears, and some even have gills! Most have more human-like faces, but some take on a more animistic look, which heightens their sense of smell, or hearing. (Please note that the male and female versions of the Tianshi are very different in appearance--females are based off of cakes, whereas the males are based off of pastries. So, please note that the genders CANNOT be changed for this particular species! Also, only male and female genders are allowed. Thank you for respecting this!)

The Tianshi also have small pets, called Yum-Yums, that help around the kitchen. You can read about them HERE:

Yum-Yums are pets of the !

Born from magic sugar crystals, they help around the kitchen, and even have their own magic to create goodies. They are soul bound to their masters, and will often take on traits of their personality. Their tails are prehensile, much like their makers, the Tianshi! There are Gen 1 and Gen 2 Yum-Yums; more info will be updated on this soon!

Most can bake a few things on their own, but some are very advanced, and can cook five course meals! (Traits are listed individually.)

Many are very fluffy, and gave canine, or feline traits. There are some rare combinations available, though!

You do NOT need to own a Tianshi to own a Yum-Yum! More info will be added later!

Here are some basic trait differences between the genders.

FEMALES: Long, thin tails, typically slender, often tall. Can have hip fins, and wings. Claws are incredibly sharp.

MALES: Shorter, thicker tails. Can have hip fins, but don't generally have wings, instead, have fins in the center of their backs. Their claws are bigger, and feet more talon-like, and are often webbed.
