



BROOKE HIGH SCHOOL HALL OF FAME



It is with great pride that the Brooke High School Athletic Hall of Fame Committee invites nominations for candidates for the Brooke High School Athletic Hall of Fame. This distinguished award honors individuals whose deeds, character and sportsmanship in the field of athletics have brought honor to themselves, to Brooke High School and to the community of Brooke County as a whole.

Eligibility Criteria:

Athletes:

- must have graduated from Brooke High School at least ten years ago.
- must have demonstrated exceptional athletic achievement during their high school tenure. (e.g., state championship, school records, all-state/all-conference honors)
- must have exhibited sportsmanship, integrity, and positive character during and after their high school career.

In addition to exceptional athletic achievements at Brooke High School, the nominees:

- may be a place winner (top 6 places) in a National Tournament. This will include all NCAA divisions, including NAIA.
- may hold an accolade during their collegiate career (eg., all-American, all-conference)
- may be a member of the United States Olympic Team in addition to an established member of any of the major professional teams.

Posthumous Induction:

- Deceased individuals may be inducted if they meet eligibility criteria.
- A family member or representative may accept the honor.

Coaches/Athletic Directors:

- must have had a minimum of **10 years** of service as a coach (in a single sport) or athletic director at the high school.
- must have demonstrated sustained success, leadership, and positive influence on student-athletes.

- must have retired or no longer coaching at the high school.

Revocation of Induction:

- Induction may be revoked in rare cases involving conduct that significantly conflicts with the values of the school.
- Revocation requires a supermajority vote of the selection committee and approval by school administration.

Nomination/Selection Processes:

- Nominations may be submitted by alumni, faculty, staff, students, or community members.
- Nomination forms must be completely filled out in order to be considered for nomination. Forms are located on the Brooke County Schools website; Paper copies are also available in the BHS Athletic Director's office or the Brooke County Board of Education office.
- Nominations must be submitted by May 1st in order to be considered for the upcoming Hall of Fame class.
- The Hall of Fame committee consists of 5-9 members, which may include administrators, alumni, and community representatives.
- The committee reviews all eligible candidates. Only candidates meeting the criteria will be considered.
- A maximum of 3 inductees will be selected each year.
- The selected Hall of Fame inductees will be announced by June 1st each year.

Induction Ceremony

- Inductions will occur annually.
- Inductees will be honored in the fall at a formal ceremony (e.g., banquet and pregame or halftime event).
- Inductees (or representatives) will receive recognition items (e.g., plaque, certificate).
