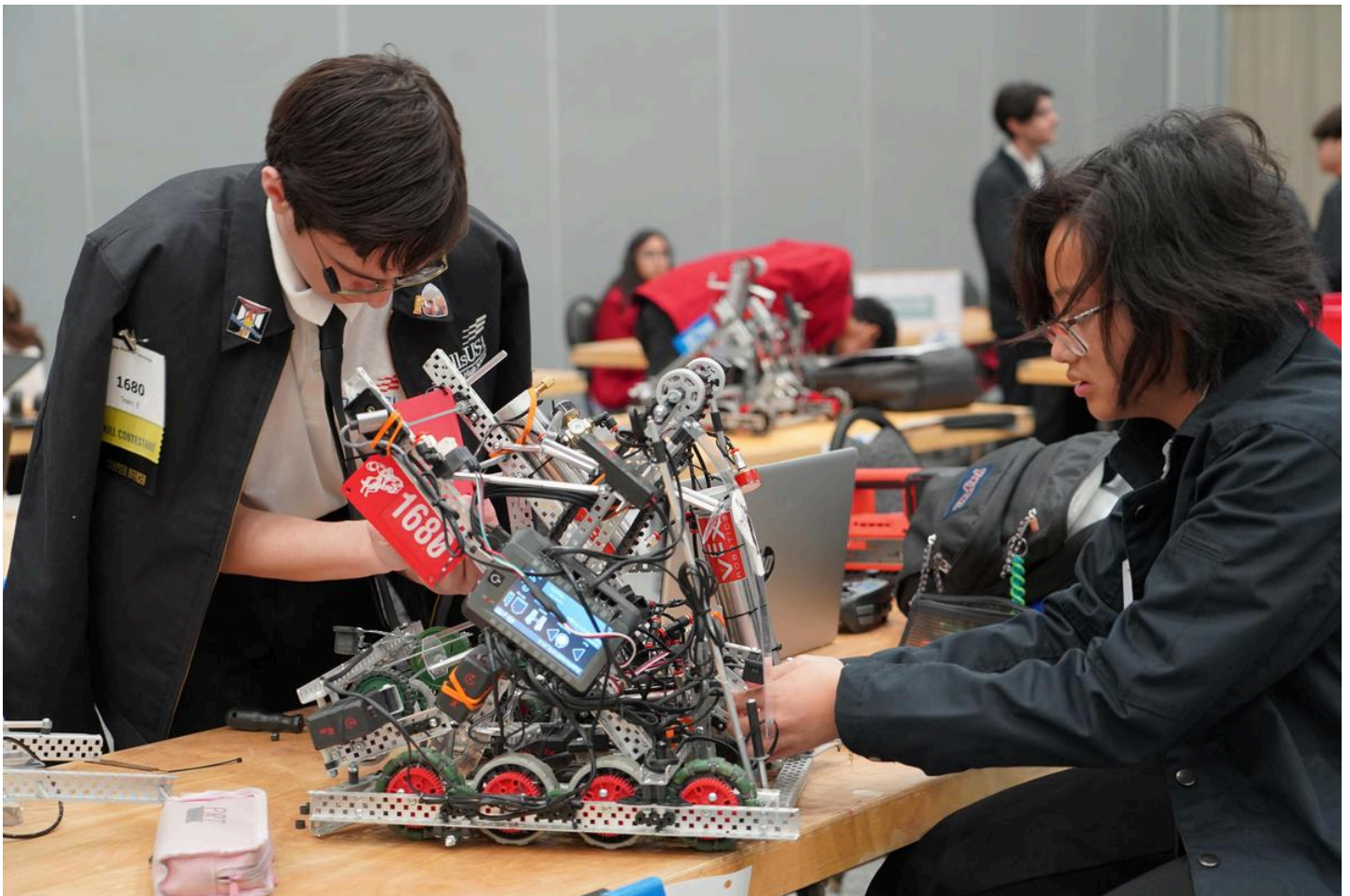
Bronze Medal – Mobile Robotics Technology

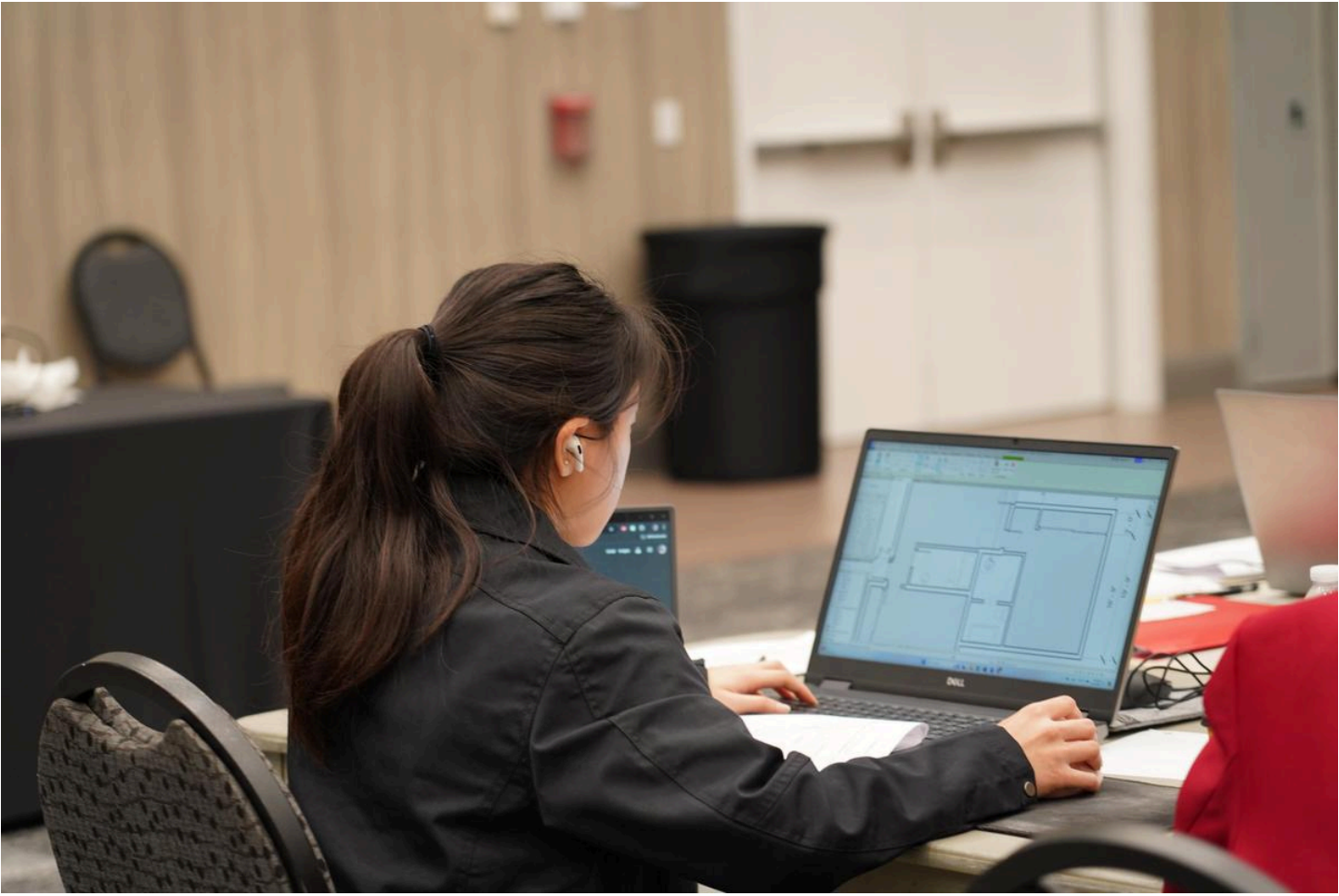
