The ACLU is also prepared:

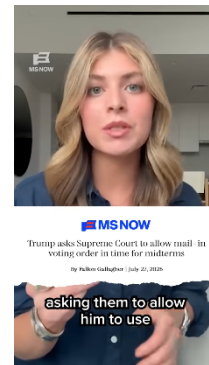
“Drawing on lessons and analysis of recent election cycles, the ACLU has identified potential threats across 25 scenarios to voting access, election administration, and certification, and stands ready to take swift legal, advocacy, and organizing action to protect voters and defend our democracy throughout the 2026 midterms and beyond.”

They have identified in their document **”The Five Electoral Phases Monitored by the ACLU”** 5 phases of the regime’s attempts to undermine the election where both the ACLU and others might take a course of action. Following are the 5 phases listed with a video explaining what the regime is doing or what they are likely to do and sometimes what action can or must take place to protect the election and our votes:

- **Before Voting Starts**

Focus Areas: Voter registration rules, purges of voter rolls, executive actions on proof of citizenship, and centralized database cross-checks.

Action/Risk: Combating unlawful attempts to restrict mail-in voting or improperly flag and remove eligible voters from registration lists.

- **During Voting**

Focus Areas: Polling place accessibility, voter intimidation, and operational constraints.

Action/Risk: Protecting access to the ballot and preventing disruptions or harassment at physical voting locations.

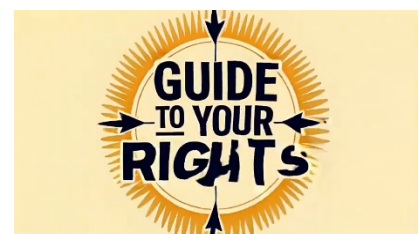

- **During the Counting**

Focus Areas: Processing of mail-in and provisional ballots, adherence to statutory deadlines, and transparency in tabulation centers.

Action/Risk: Ensuring that every legally cast vote is accurately processed and counted without arbitrary interference.

- **When the Winner is Declared**

Focus Areas: Public misinformation, premature or contested claims, and pressure campaigns on election media/officials.

Action/Risk: Countering false narratives designed to cast generalized doubt on the integrity of the outcome.

- **Certifying and Seating the Winner**

Focus Areas: Local and state-level canvassing boards, ministerial certification duties, and final electoral vote compilation.

Action/Risk: Preventing rogue officials from blocking the legal certification of results or refusing to seat confirmed winners

Several designs were discussed with these or some slightly altered version of these being more popular:



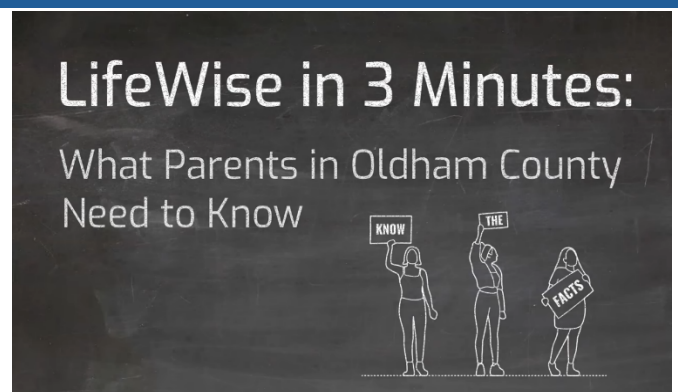
An option that was brought up later as a 12 x 12 yard sign would be something like this:

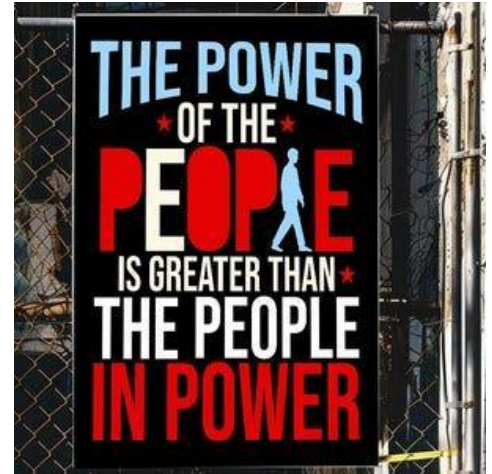
