Here's my GEPIWAT Experience at SCMHRD.

Date: 13 Feb 2020

Slot: 8 AM

We were seated in an Audi for the first hour or so, and this is where you get your biometric and SNAP C form verified. Once you are done. You will be taken to a separate room for your WAT. You may have to wait for a while for the WAT to start since they start only when everyone in your slot is done.

There were 2 WATs. The first was something along the lines of "Is India on the brink of innovation with its large working population. For or Against." The second one included 2 pictures, one with a single light bulb amidst a swarm of broken ones, and the other with an image of a butterfly, divided into 2 halves, one in black and the other in colour. I think I faired well in this.

The second GD was about selecting 4 headlines amongst 7 given ones, and come up with a consensus amongst the group. We had 1 minute each to speak on our selected ones and then discuss for a few minutes and later present in the last 2 minutes. I did well, although I couldn't complete me intro in the 1 minute given and had to stop midway, and stammered for a second during the presentation (I stammer, the words just don't come out, so I went "Kya bolte hain" really quickly for a second or so and went on with my point.
