In our last episode, Pacha the Dreamer was in the International Climate Collaboratory, 200 miles in space, circling the human race.

We invite children of all ages to plant Seed Ideas in the Gardens of Global Unity, where all things are possible. These become part of our collaborative storytelling adventure. As we go through the year, our children and youth ask for help in growing these Seed Ideas from vision to reality. They call on adults and elders in local and global networks of support. The musical play produced in April will feature true stories of real people bringing the Global Goals to life.

SEED IDEAS. These are some of the Seed Ideas growing in the Gardens of Global Unity.

1. **Printernet Gazette** - Each month, you'll find the songs and games, activities and resources to engage children, youth, adults and elders in the collaborative storytelling adventure.
2. **Roving Reporters** interview people who are living the Global Goals and submit them for publication. Selected stories (written and video) will be featured in the Printernet Gazette and "Climate Collaboratory: The Musical."
3. **Trillion Trees Challenge** - Trees are the lungs of our planet. They help to clean out carbon pollution for a livable Earth. Pacha and Paco ask everyone to take the Trillion Trees Challenge.
4. **Beloved Community Choir** - Pacha and Paco join people of faith and goodwill getting ready to sing in Martin Luther King's World House.
5. **Building Community in a Changing Climate** - Pacha and Paco invite people of all ages to find their part in the community-wide climate conversation-to-action program.
6. **EarthFlash! Games Show** - Young people host a live stream game show for the human family, with games and activities for all ages.
7. **EarthFlash! Games** - These are all in development, to be played month by month on the Road to Earth Day in April 2022.
