- mainstream and alternative systems of education and development.

QUALITY CONTROL

Please note that the Programme Committee ensures quality at every step of preparation for the Conference:

1) Speakers School

Each of the speakers will be asked to watch several videos and participate in 2-5 webinars dedicated to different aspects of being a speaker

2) Run-throughs

It is obligatory for every speaker to arrange and attend at least one run-through of their talk.

3) Recording

To ensure high quality of the video for participants we will record your talk beforehand.

4) Audience feedback

After the Conference we will collect the feedback on the speaker's performance and will rely on it when choosing speakers the next time.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- 1) The talk must contain up-to-date information and be relevant to the topic of the conference
- 2) The talk should be new and not presented at any other conferences
- 3) Every element of the "Call for papers" form should be correctly filled

THE TALK CANNOT BE PROMOTIONAL. ONLY THE LAST SLIDE CAN BE DEDICATED TO PROMOTING SPEAKER'S MATERIALS OR COURSES.
