#### MESSAGE ON PERSONAL MOBILE DEVICES

- ★ UPDATE: We continue to experience students having smart watches and PMDs at Westbrook. We have encouraged parents and students to leave these devices at home, completely off, and in their backpacks during the school day.
- ★ Usage on the bus is permitted as allowed by the bus driver. All devices should be silenced while on the bus, or headphones may be used.
- ★ It is against MCPS policy and the Code of Conduct to record or distribute images of other children.
- ★ This policy extends beyond just testing days!
- \* Any student who violates this policy will have the device confiscated by administration. Confiscated devices will be available for pickup in the front office by an adult.

We value the needs of all our students and strive to support them. We can help facilitate communication while students are at school. However, we must adhere to the MCPS policy regarding PMD usage, which states that <u>PMDs may be confiscated</u> if not used following these guidelines. Any confiscated device may be picked up will by a parent or caregiver. Contact administration if you have any questions.

## Possible Next Steps from March PTA Meeting

Several parents have reached out to suggest next steps following the March PTA meeting. Please email the PTA to let us know if you would be interested in participating in and/or exploring any of these as a school community.



- Wait Til 8th pledge: Wait Til 8th offers a place for parents to pledge, alongside other parents at their kids' school, not to give their children a smartphone until at least the 8th grade. By signing the online pledge, you promise not to give your child a smartphone until at least the end of 8th grade as long as at least 10 families total from your child's grade and school pledge. Once 10 families from a grade have pledged to delay the smartphone, you will be notified that the pledge is active and receive a list of families who are delaying from your child's grade and emails for the parents. If this feels aligned for your family, we encourage you to sign up and help make Westbrook a Wait Til 8th school!
- Parent book club: The Anxious Generation by Jonathan Haight. Many of you have likely already read or heard of <a href="this book">this book</a>, which connects the current mental health crisis among youth and young adults to the rise of smartphones and the decline of independent play in childhood. If you would be interested in reading the book alongside other parents and discussing it before the end of the year, please let us know. If 10 parents sign up, the PTA will work to coordinate a book group and discussion.


