Program Description

The Bachelor of Science in Healthcare Management, Minor in Health Ministry at HBIU University is a specialized program designed for students interested in managing healthcare organizations while incorporating faith-based principles. Practicum Requirement

As part of the degree, students are required to complete a practicum to gain hands-on experience in healthcare management or health ministry.

Practicum Requirements:

- Complete a minimum of 150 supervised hours in a healthcare facility, church health ministry, or faith-based healthcare organization.
- Engage in administrative tasks, patient care management, and ministry-focused healthcare service delivery.
- Submit a detailed reflection report summarizing key experiences and learnings.
- Participate in professional development and mentorship sessions in healthcare ministry and management.

This practicum allows students to apply theoretical knowledge in real-world healthcare settings for faith-based ministries and church health programs.

Capstone Project (15 Credit Hours)

The capstone project serves as a culminating experience, allowing students to apply healthcare management strategies, health ministry principles, and ethical decision-making in a final project.

Students will:

- Develop a comprehensive healthcare administration plan for a faith-based organization or non-profit health ministry.
- Design a health ministry program that integrates spiritual care with healthcare services in a church setting.
- Evaluate the impact of health ministry programs and propose improvements for better community outreach and healthcare delivery.
- Present findings and recommendations through a formal report and presentation.

This experience ensures students graduate with practical expertise in healthcare administration, health ministry, and ethical service in health organizations.

Program Outcomes

- Gain expertise in healthcare administration, health policy, and patient care management.
- Develop skills in healthcare leadership, strategic planning, and human resources management in healthcare settings.
- Apply biblical principles in healthcare service delivery, spiritual care, and health ministry management.
- Conduct research on healthcare systems and develop health ministry programs that integrate Christian values in patient care.
- Implement effective healthcare strategies, ethical decision-making, and ministry-focused health services.
