What is my status as an employee at MassArt?

It's important to know that non-unit member adjuncts, unit member adjuncts, and continuing education instructors all get compensated differently for their work, even in situations where that work is functionally the same.

For example, an adjunct teaching their first semester at MassArt will be paid **\$6000** for a 4-credit course. If you have taught at MassArt for three or more semesters, you would get a non-unit member rate of **\$8,295.66** for the same course. That is a 28% raise! If you have taught for three *consecutive* semesters, you would get the unit member rate of **\$9,014.39** for the same course—a 33% raise! Linked here are the current pay rates for daytime faculty:
