

Позакласний захід
з англійської мови
"Now we know the ABC"



Мета:

- в ігровій формі перевірити знання учнями англійського алфавіту, вміння рахувати від 1 до 10, вміння спілкуватися, перевірити знання учнів з тем «Кольори», «Сім'я», «Пори року»;
- розвивати навички усного монологічного і діалогічного мовлення та аудіювання;
- виховувати почуття відповідальності за спільну справу, інтерес до вивчення англійської мови.

Обладнання: роздатковий матеріал, наочний матеріал; святково прикрашений актовий зал, магнітофон, мультимедійний проектор.

Хід заходу

Ми уже майже рік вивчаємо англійську мову і багато всього знаємо і вміємо. Сьогодні ми підготували Свято алфавіту. Та спершу давайте привітаємось.

(звучить пісня «Good morning» поки всі сідають на місця)

I. Greeting.

T: Good morning, dear boys and girls, parents and teachers. You are welcome to our “ABC PARTY”. And now I’d like to see if all the letters of English alphabet are here (діти, кожний зі своєю літерою і малюнком виходять і стають в ряд).

You are welcome letters! (кожна літера себе представляє).

1. **A is for apples and apple-trees. You can see apples on apple – trees.**
2. **B is for books and for bookcase. I have many books in my bookcase.**
3. **C is for cat. My cat is grey. And with me it likes to play.**
4. **D is for dog and for doggy. I have a dog, not a doggy.**
5. **E is for eight and for eleven. How much is eight and eleven?**
6. **F is for flowers: red and blue, white and yellow and rosy, too.**
7. **G is for girl, and also for garden. I see a girl going to the garden.**
8. **H is for a hand. I have two hands.**
9. **I is for I. I am a boy and I am seven.**
10. **J is for jam. This is an apple jam. Jimmy likes it and so does Sam.**
11. **K is for kite. Kate has a kite. It is little and it is white.**
12. **L is for letter. This letter is for me. It is from my sister, as you can see.**
13. **M is for May and for May Day, for March and for Mother’s Day.**
14. **N is for nine, ninety and ninety-nine. Children, how much is ninety and nine?**
15. **O is for one. One and two is three. Three cats are in a tree.**
16. **P is for pencils. With them I draw: a red pen, a green tree or a blue door.**
17. **Q is for question: How are you?**

18. **R is for red. Many things are red. What can be red? Do you know, friend?**
19. **S is for street. This is my street. There are many trees in my street.**
20. **T is for tick and for tock. Tick-tock, tick-tock – merrily sings the clock.**
21. **U is for under, but not for at. I am under the tree, says Pat.**
22. **V is in five and also in seven. It is in twelve and in eleven.**
23. **W is for winter when it is cold. But I like winter and I like cold.**
24. **X is in six. Let's count up to six!**
25. **Y is for yard where children play. They play in the yard every day.**
26. **Z is for the zoo. Let's go to the zoo. I like to go to the zoo. And you?**

T: And now let's sing the song "ABC" altogether (всі разом співають пісню «ABC»).

T: Thank you our letters. Take your seats and show what you know.

II. Spell the word. Вчитель показує слова, учень повинен сказати його по буквах, а потім прочитати.

T: I see that you can read well. But can you count in English?

1. Count from 1 to 12. Учасники кожної команди рахують від 1 до 12.

2. Count from 12 to 1. Учні рахують у зворотному порядку.

3. What numerals are missing? Вчитель показує картки з числівниками, але деяких не вистачає. Назвати їх.

T: Now I'd like to see, who is the best in Maths.

1. Do the sums. Вчитель показує картку з прикладом в межах 12, учень каже весь приклад англійською і дає відповідь:

$$2+3=$$

$$10-7=$$

$$1+6=$$

$$8-2=$$

$$4+5=$$

$$12-1=$$

2. Tell the poems.

1,1,1 – little dogs run

2,2,2 – cat see you

3,3,3 – birds on the tree

4,4,4 – mice on the floor.

One, two. Look at the shoe.

Three, four. Look at the door.

Five, six. Look at the chicks.

Seven, eight. Look at the plate.

Nine, ten. Look at the pen.

One, two. How are you?

Three, four. Who's at the door?

Five, six. My name is Fix.

Seven, eight. Sorry, I'm late.

Nine, ten. Say it again.

I am eleven, my sister is seven,

My mother is thirty, my father is forty.

My granny is seventy-two.

And you? How old are you?

One, two, three, four, come in, please, and shut the door.

Five, six, seven, eight it's time to school. You're very late.

Nine, ten, nine, ten, don't be late for school again.

T: Ok. You worked very hard and should have a rest. Let's do our exercises.

(Робимо зарядку під пісню „**Hockey-Cockey**”).

T: We all see that you know the numbers and can count well. But do you know the colours?

1. Name the colours. Вчитель показує колір, учні називають його англійською.

2. Recite the poems about colours.

Spring is green,

Summer is bright,

Autumn is yellow,

Winter is white.

Colours

- What is grey? Can you say?
- Yes, I can. My cat is grey.
- Can you say what is brown?
- My ball is brown. It can jump up and down.
 - What is white I want to know?
 - Milk is white and so is snow.

- What is green? Tell me please.
- The grass is green, so is a tree.

3. Sing the song 'What colour is the sky?'

T: Ok. But we learnt a lot of other poems. Who wants to tell us some of them?
