

Task: You need to create and present your own perfect country, that is to say, a Utopia.

GUIDELINE

- 1. Name of the country. Choose a suitable and original name that defines your country. Capital city and main important cities.
- 2. **Geographical location** and map. As a group, discuss and decide where you will find your Utopia. Explain why you have taken this decision and show it on the map in relation to the rest of the countries of the world. Explain the climate and the natural environment in the area where it is located.
- 3. **Population.** Explain the most important features of its population: the number of inhabitants, population density, rural/urban, ethnic groups that comprise it, etc.
- 4. Language. Explain your choice briefly and the main features of the language.
- 5. Create a sentence similar to a "**slogan**" that identifies your country and their way of life. Explain your choice.
- 6. Design your own **flag** in order to identify the country at international level. It must be new and original. Explain your choice.
- 7. Decide what type of **Government** your country has. How is it structured? Is it a monarchy, a democracy, an anarchy, a dictatorship, maybe something that combines the best of them or maybe something new? How will decisions be taken? Explain your choice.
- 8. **Legal system**. Rules, laws, penalties and sanctions, etc. Develop a list of 10 laws/rules associated with the most basic function of the country that all citizens of the country have to comply with. Consider the penalties to be applied for any incompletion.
- 9. **Economic System.** Do you pay taxes? How long is the working day? Are there pensions, grants, various subsidies?
- 10. Health system. Measures in case of a pandemic
- 11. **Supplies of basic needs** (economic sectors): How does it work in your country? Among others you should include the following points: water, food, clothing and transport.
- 12. Talk about other aspects that seem relevant to you, for example, **sports, artistic manifestations**, cultural heritage, Festivals, etc.
- 13. Education. Explain the educational system in your country and your choice

- 14. **Religion**. What is the religion of your country? Is there an established one? Is it a secular country? Is there freedom of religion? Explain your choice.
- 15. Finally, decide **why** your Utopia is perfect and explain it in a way that is understandable and reasonable.
