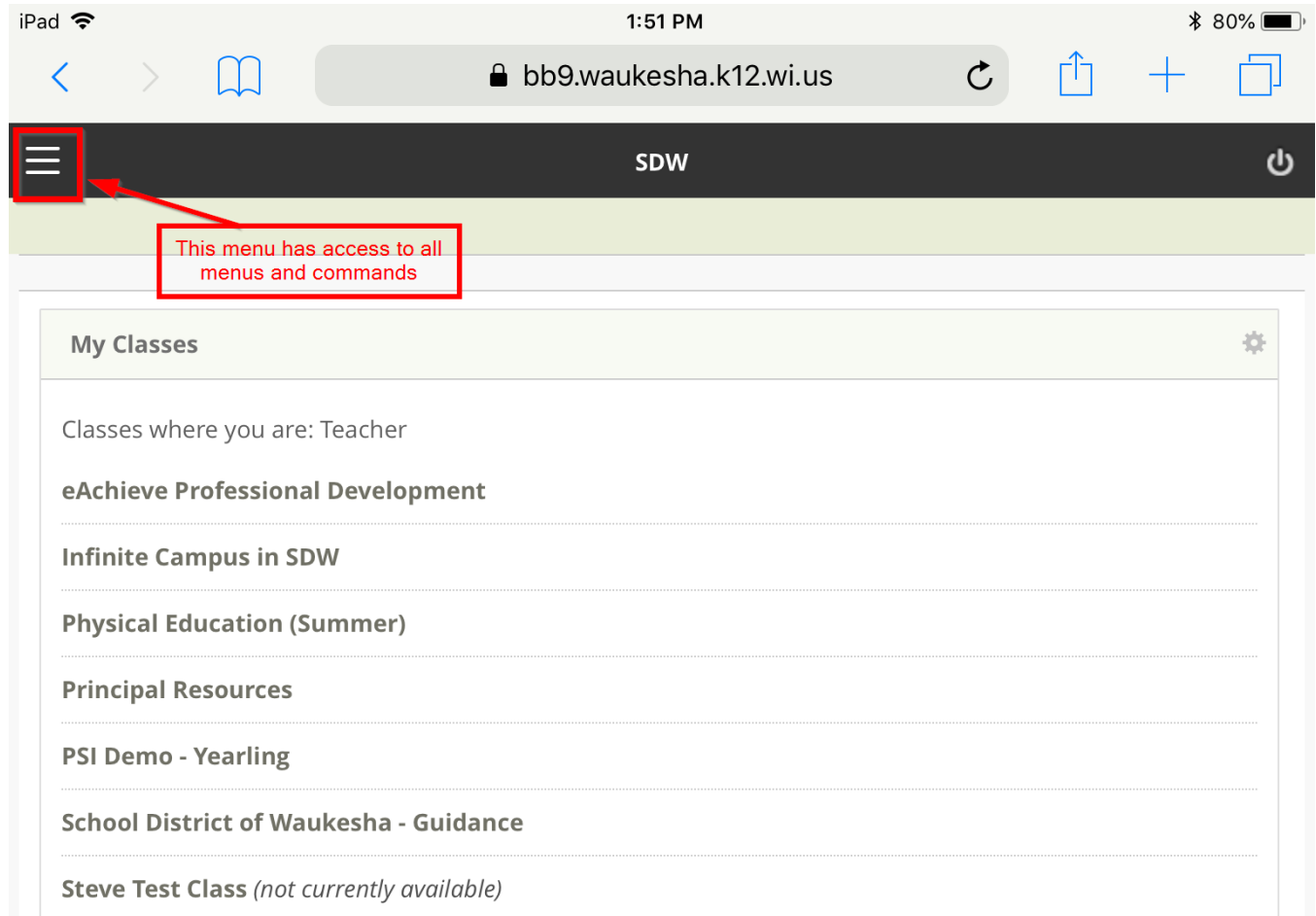


Blackboard User Interface changes on iPads

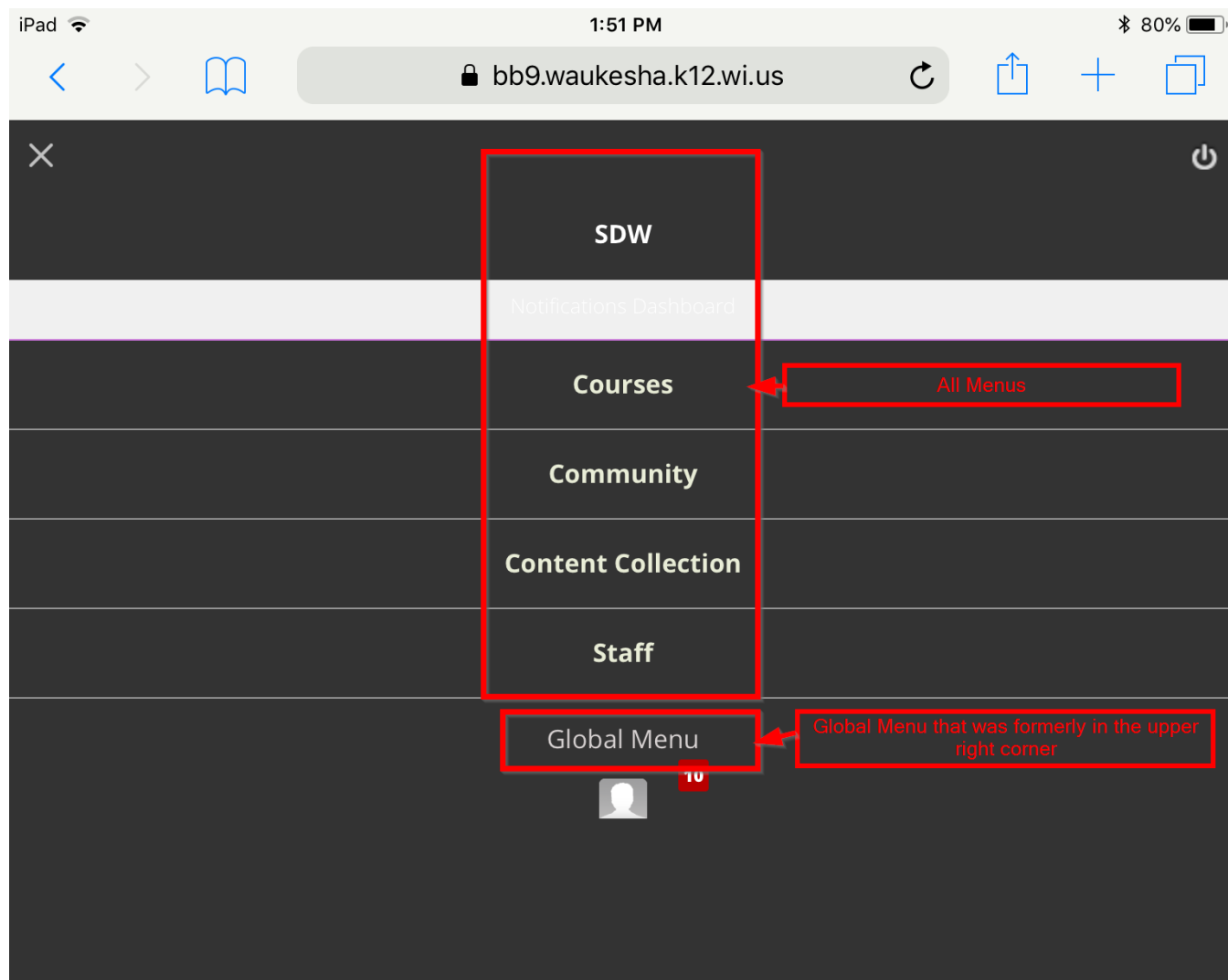

Blackboard has updated their user interface specifically for mobile devices. Mobile devices have much smaller and narrower screens so menus and content need to be designed to go down the page instead of across the page. This allows the application to continue to be usable as screen size shrinks. This type of design is called “responsive design” which means that it adjusts (responds) to changes in screen size and shape. Here are some significant changes in the way the BB9 interface operates on mobile devices such as iPads and phones.

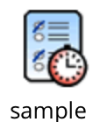
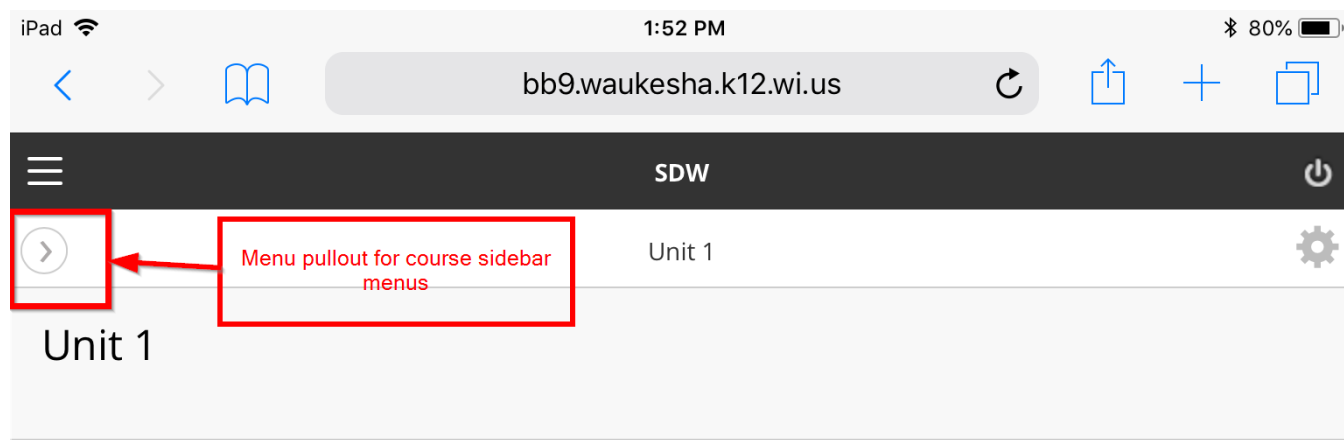
All menus and commands are now located under the single menu on the left side of the screen.



Once that menu is opened it reveals all of the menu picks that formerly were across the top of the screen. This includes the global menu that was formerly in the upper right corner of the screen.



Once you enter a course you will notice another pull out icon that can be used to access all of the course sidebar menus.
