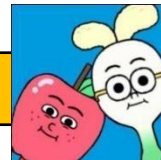


GRAMMAR: POSSESSIVES (Adj.)



POSESIVOS (POSSESSIVES)

- Los posesivos son palabras que sirven para indicar posesión, es decir, a quién pertenecen las cosas. Se colocan delante de los sustantivos:

MY = **MI** --> **My car is green** = **Mi coche es verde**

YOUR = **TU** --> **Your car is green**

HIS = **SU** (DE UN CHICO) --> **His car is green**

HER = **SU** (DE UNA CHICA) --> **Her car is green**

ITS = **SU** (DE UNA COSA) --> **Its legs are blue**

OUR = **NUESTRO/A** --> **Our car is green**

YOUR = **VUESTRO/A** --> **Your car is green**

THEIR = **SU** (DE ELLOS/AS) --> **They wash their hands**
