- Commission: the most affected individuals by climate change, security, and stability are all under threat. Global solidarity is needed. The Paris Agreement is a breakthrough in multilateralism, for more than a decade, we worked on this document. We regret the withdrawal from the new US Administration. We continue to engage on a private level with the US government. We remain committed to addressing climate change ahead of COP 30.

The withdrawal from the WHO is another concern. Pandemics know no borders it affected international cooperation, economy, and health. The WHO is a cornerstone of international health cooperation, we stand firm behind the WHO to protect the most vulnerable. We are the largest contributor to the WHO, and we will continue with that.

USAID supported millions of lives. But which projects are lifesaving? The long-term interests of the USA are affected by this approach. It affects the international community.

This vacuum opens the way for anti-western narratives. We reassure you, however, that we will not step back from our development and humanitarian assistance. Advancing global development and combating poverty remain our priorities.

The humanitarian system is underfunded, the EU and its member states cannot fill the gap. Everyone must help as an international community.

The executive orders from President Trump will have a serious impact on the multilateral system. This challenges international cooperation, security and public health.

Our multilateral system is far from perfect, but listening to the rules is essential in this regard. We therefore continue to work with the EU.
