PARENT/GUARDIAN WAIVER - MUST RETURN TO ATTEND
ASHEVILLE MIDDLE SCHOOL/MNSA 8TH GRADE END OF YEAR CELEBRATION

Dear Parents/Guardians of Asheville Middle and Montford North Star 8th grade students:

What – 2023 8th Grade End of Year Celebration and Dance (food and beverages included)

When – Friday May 12th from 6:00 – 9:00pm

Where – UNCA Highsmith Student Union, Alumni Hall

Cost - \$10/ticket (no student will be turned away for inability to pay) – cash only

Tickets will be on sale Monday May 8th – Thursday May 11th during lunch in the cafeteria.

This waiver MUST be returned by May 11th. Tickets can NOT be purchased at the event.

Please review the following expectations with your child, sign the attached *Parental-Consent Form, Release, and Assumption of Risk*, and have your child return the form when purchasing their ticket.

Student Expectations:

1. At the event, your child must check in at the registration table. Once the student checks in, they will be issued a wristband, which must be worn at all times during the event. Any person at the event who is not wearing an authorized wristband may be escorted from the premises by one of the security officers on duty. **NO BAGS WILL BE PERMITTED AT THE EVENT**
2. Security will be provided by Asheville Police Department whose officers will be working as independent contractors for this event. This officer and each adult volunteer at the event will have the authority to exclude or remove anyone from the event for any reason.
3. While this event is not organized or sponsored by Asheville City Schools (ACS), it is expected that the ACS Code of Student Conduct 2022-2023 and ACS Student Behavior Policies will be followed at all times by all participants, including, but not limited to:
 - acting with integrity, civility, responsibility, and self-control (Code 4310)
 - not cursing or using vulgar, abusive, or demeaning language (Code 4310)
 - not using or possessing any tobacco product, including electronic cigarettes and all lighted and smokeless tobacco products (Code 4320)
 - not possessing, using, transmitting, selling, or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs (Code 4325)
 - not committing theft or damage to property (Code 4330)
 - not fighting, assaulting, threatening, or harassing another person (Code 4331) and •
 - not possessing any weapons or weapon-like items (Code 4333)
4. Appropriate dress and decorum are expected. The ACS Student Dress Code (Code 4316) will

generally be in effect, and clothing that is provocative or obscene will not be permitted, at the sole discretion of the parent volunteers at the event.

Parental/Guardian Consent Form, Release, and Assumption of Risk

I agree that my child's participation in the *2023 8th Grade End of Year Celebration and Dance* is purely voluntary, and that any participation is done in spite of the risks.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY/INDEMNIFICATION: By signing this Agreement, I hereby release the AMS PTO, Montford PTO, parents and/or any of its volunteers from any and all claims, damages, and liabilities of any nature arising out of the *2023 8th Grade End of Year Celebration and Dance*.
