

Political Action

The Political Action Committee shall:

- (1) seek to increase registration and voting;
- (2) work for the enactment of municipal, state and federal legislation designed to improve the educational, political and economic status of minority groups;
- (3) seek the repeal of racially discriminatory legislation;
- (4) work to improve the administration of justice;
- (5) work to secure equal enforcement of the law; and
- (6) keep the National Office and the Unit informed of all proposed legislation which affects minority groups. The Committee shall be nonpartisan and shall not endorse candidates for public office.
