

What do you need to do to earn an IB diploma?

IB Classes

- Successfully complete IB classes in six required subjects: **English, World Language, History, Science, Math**, and one **Elective** of your choice (IB Psychology, IB Anthropology, IB Theater, IB Art, or a 2nd IB Science).

Internal Assessments

- Successfully complete all the “Internal Assessments” (projects in each IB class that count toward your IB exam score).

IB Exams

- Pass **six IB exams**, including **at least three HL (higher level) exams**, with scores of 4* or better.

TOK

- Successfully complete the class “Theory of Knowledge” and complete the required **TOK Exhibition** and **TOK Essay**.

CAS

- Perform at least 50 hours each of “Creativity, Activity, and Service” (150 hours total over two years).

Extended Essay

- Complete a 3000 - 4000 word Extended Essay (research paper) in the subject of your choice.

Ethical Standards

- Uphold IB’s policy on academic honesty at all times.

*In some cases it is still possible for a student to earn an IB diploma if they score less than a 4 on an exam. However, to be safe you should aim for score of 4 or above in all subjects.
