

Weed for Warriors Project SB-34 Supply Drop Veteran Checklist

In order to participate in WFWP SB-34 Supply drops the veteran must have PHYSICAL COPIES of

1. proof of military service
2. a valid government issued photo ID
3. a current Medical Marijuana Card

You cannot participate in the Supply Drops without these documents

1. Acceptable forms of Proof of Service

- DOD issued ID
- Current/Valid State ID with veteran verification – meets both proof of service and photo ID requirements
- VA hospital issued ID – **Must say “service connected” or Branch Insignia**
- DD-214*
- VA Award Letter*
- VA Benefits Summary*
- Discharge Certificate*

These items MUST be accompanied by a current, state issued, photo ID

2. Hard Copy of current California Medical Marijuana Card – SB-34 legislation REQUIRES medical cannabis recommendations

YOU MUST PRESENT A HARD COPY OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION AT EVERY WFW SB-34 SUPPLY DROP. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOU NOT BEING ABLE TO RECEIVE A FREE MEDICAL DONATION THROUGH OUR PROGRAM.

WFWP SB-34 Events Code of Conduct

We honor and respect the sacrifices and journey of each of the warriors who attend WFWP events. The Volunteer Leaders work hard to organize and execute events STATEWIDE. As attendance grows, we want to gently remind all participants of some basic expectations and standards while participating in events and interacting with those supporting our events. Failure to comply will result in being excused from the current and possibly future events.

- Be polite, respectful and supportive to others – this includes but not limited to your language, tone, tact, clothing etc... be mindful of those around you.
- Follow Directives given by WFW leadership or Dispensary Staff
- WFW leadership and Dispensary staff have the right to refuse service and prohibit future attendance of SB-34 events.
- NO SMOKING on or near dispensary property.

- Under SB-34, items designated for WFW donation may only be provided to a medical patient through a licensed retailer. Any resale of donated goods is prohibited by California state law and will result in a minimum suspension of 30 days up to a lifetime ban from all WFW Supply Drops.

SB-34 FAQ

What is CA SB-34?

When CA voters voted to legalize Recreational Cannabis in 2016, the legislation did away with compassionate medicine – or a legal pathway to giving free products to users looking for relief from their chronic conditions. [Senate Bill 34](#) (Weiner) or the Dennis Peron and Brownie Mary Act, was originally vetoed by Governor Brown, but was eventually passed in 2018 by Governor Newsom. This recreated a pathway for medicine to move through the supply chain to these patients safely.

How do SB-34 Supply Drops work?

Before the Event: We are 100% donation based – we do our best to stretch everything out to as many as we can. Donations come to WFWP from many levels of the supply chain. WFW coordinates communications between parties and organizes logistics for all donations. It is our goal to post event announcements two weeks ahead, but sometimes we get donations last minute. At the event: These events are exclusively for United States Military Disabled Veterans participating under California SB-34 guidelines. Weed for Warriors Project leadership and participating dispensaries reserve the legal right under SB-34 to refuse participation or service to any non-veteran attempting to participate in veteran-only supply drop events.

Event start times will vary and are listed on each official event flyer. These events are first come, first served until supplies last. All Veteran Patients will be checked in according to their place in line. Participating dispensaries will handle and distribute all SB-34 supply drops in accordance with California state law and dispensary compliance procedures. Please have all required hard-copy documentation ready at the time of check-in. Failure to provide all required hard-copy documentation will result in removal from eligibility for participation.

After the event: If you have questions about your donations, you can reach out to the WFWP leadership that was at the event. Please do not consume donations on site at the events – this puts the dispensaries that support us at risk for fines and closure.
