All work will be graded and counted for your Grade in one of the following categories:

College Readiness Grade: (10% of grade)

- in class and on time
- deadlines met for daily synchronous/asynchronous assignments
- respectful and appropriate communication with teachers and students

Application of Knowledge Grade: (40% of grade)

- verbal and written synchronous and asynchronous work
- drafts of larger projects
- quizzes and other small assessments

Mastery of Knowledge Grade: (50% of grade)

- Final Projects, Presentations, Essays, Tests or Exams (Artifacts!)
