DEVISING DRAMA

You will work in groups to devise a drama based on one of your scripted performances from 2.1 or 2.6. This must be a stand alone work that doesn't require the knowledge of the script you previously worked on. You will workshop, craft and select what to include in your performance. As a group you will rehearse and refine the work, focusing on drama elements, conventions and technologies. You will perform this work to an audience of your class and another drama class.
