Girl Child Network is a membership organization that brings together National Non Governmental Organizations (NNGOs), Faith Based Organizations (FBOs), Community Based Organizations (CBOs), Women Groups, Youth Groups, and individuals together with the aim of amplifying children's, youth's and women's voices as a national, regional and global agenda towards attainment of all the Sustainable Development Goals. Members are drawn from diverse sectors that include education, gender and governance, research, health, livelihoods, policy advocacy among other sub-sectors of development.

CHILDREN ON THE MARGINS PROJECT

Children on the Margin is a multi-year program being implemented in the counties of Turkana, Wajir, Isiolo, and Kajiado. The program aims to reduce school dropouts and improve transition and retention rates by addressing systemic barriers to education such as poverty, cultural attitudes, inadequate infrastructure, and limited parental involvement. It targets vulnerable children—particularly those at risk of exclusion—by enhancing their agency, life skills, and social-emotional development to support holistic growth and learning.

The program works with public schools across Pre-Primary, Primary, and Junior Secondary levels and seeks to strengthen education systems by embedding Life Skills and Values (LSV) into teaching, learning, and policy structures. It also focuses on creating inclusive learning pathways for children who have dropped out of school, including bridging and vocational training options.

Girl Child Network (GCN) is implementing the Children on the Margin Project in partnership with UNICEF and financial support from Porticus in Turkana County, Turkana South and Aroo Sub Counties. The project's primary goal is that children in ASAL areas demonstrate improved agency on matters that impact their holistic development.

Girl Child Network (GCN) invites Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from qualified individual consultants or firms for the provision of consultancy services to Review and Contextualize existing Life Skills and Values (LSV) materials for effective dissemination and mainstreaming in education.

Scope of Work

The consultant/firm will be expected to:

1. Review existing LSV documents and resources.
2. Align the materials with the Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC), national education policies, and inclusive education priorities.

3. Refine and adapt the materials to ensure they are practical, user-friendly, and relevant for learners, teachers, education officers, and other stakeholders.
4. Produce a final set of contextualized LSV resources and a technical report outlining the process, key recommendations, and adaptations made.

The assignment will be carried out between 1st– 12th September 2025 (10 working days).

Deliverables

- Reviewed and contextualized LSV materials ready for dissemination and implementation.
- Technical report highlighting key recommendations and alignment with CBC and inclusive education frameworks.
- Final user-friendly LSV resources for use by learners, educators and stakeholders.

Consultant Qualifications

Interested consultants/firms should meet the following minimum requirements:

- Proven expertise in curriculum development, education policy, and/or life skills and values education.
- Demonstrated experience in contextualizing or adapting training/teaching materials.
- Strong understanding of Kenya's Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC) and inclusive education approaches.
- At least 5 years' relevant professional experience.
- Degree in education, social sciences or a related discipline from a recognized institution.
- Excellent analytical, writing, and communication skills.

Submission Requirements

Expressions of Interest should include the following documents:

- Company/individual profile and CV(s) of proposed consultant(s).
- Technical proposal outlining the consultant's understanding of the assignment, methodology, and work plan.
- Financial proposal (inclusive of all applicable taxes).
- Copies of registration/incorporation certificate (for firms), KRA PIN certificate, valid Tax Compliance Certificate, and other relevant statutory documents.
