The Local GP Route

Your GP is often the natural starting point, but most general practitioners have limited experience managing testosterone replacement as an ongoing treatment. They may test total testosterone without the nuance of free testosterone and sex hormone-binding globulin (SHBG), dismiss borderline results, or begin a referral chain that adds months before treatment starts. GPs also tend towards conservative dosing and less comprehensive monitoring than hormone specialists provide.

Specialist Referral Through the Public System

An endocrinologist with TRT experience represents thorough in-person specialist care, but accessing one from Bundaberg involves significant practical hurdles. Referral wait times for non-urgent specialist appointments in regional Queensland commonly run several months, and frequently extend well beyond that in less-serviced areas. Factor in repeat blood tests, follow-up appointments, and potential travel to Brisbane or Rockhampton, and the total timeline from first GP visit to first treatment dose can stretch to 4–8 months.

Injectable Testosterone

Injectable testosterone enanthate or cypionate represents the clinical gold standard for TRT in Australia. Administered via subcutaneous injection using insulin syringes, it's virtually painless and easily self-administered at home after initial training during your video consultation.

At \$28 per 1ml, injections deliver unmatched cost-effectiveness alongside superior clinical characteristics: precise dosing control, predictable absorption, and stable hormone levels when administered at an appropriate frequency. Most protocols involve injections once or twice weekly, with more frequent, smaller doses producing steadier levels and fewer side effects than larger, less frequent administration.

Topical Testosterone: The Needle-Free Alternative

Gels and creams applied daily to the skin offer convenience for men with genuine needle aversion. They maintain relatively stable daily testosterone levels without the peaks and troughs that can occur with less frequent injections. However, the practical trade-offs are meaningful: higher monthly costs than injectables, strict daily application timing, and transference risk requiring careful hygiene to prevent accidental testosterone exposure to partners or children.

How do I access TRT assessment in Bundaberg?
