Historical Background

The Nurse of the Day service began in 1991 when many schools in SFUSD did not have a school nurse and would otherwise not have access to current, reliable health information.

Who is the Nurse of the Day?

The Nurse of the Day (NOD) is a centrally-assigned School District Nurse who is available through the Student and Family Resource Link, and who is knowledgeable of the district's health-related policies and procedures.

What is the Goal of the Service?

The Nurse of the Day (NOD) service is dedicated to providing timely response based on current health-related policies and procedures to students, employees, parents/caregivers and community-based organizations in SFUSD.
