nGe or GeGe

- Geo is made up of rounded, line pattern markings that look sort of like a contour map.
- It's always black or darker than the base.






VARIANT EXPRESSION:




WITH WINGS:

- Geo does not have to show up on the wings at all. It does not have to follow spread or density rules, but if you want a more cohesive design, you can follow them.
- The example below shows the max amount of Geo allowed on the wings.



WITH SECONDARIES:

- ☑ fill the marking
- outline the whole marking
- Fill between the mark, skipping every other ring
- do not fill the whole marking
- do not add secondary rings between the primary rings
