- 5) You must have a 3.3 GPA or higher.
- 6) Write an essay to accompany this application and discuss what being a student-athlete has
- meant to you and how it has impacted your life. This letter will be crucial in making the final
- scholarship decisions. Letters must be typed and should not exceed more than 2 pages in

length. This is your chance to showcase Y-O-U!

7) Your completed application packet must be sent by email to erica@denverathletic.com and

be received no later than 5:00pm, on Friday, April 11, 2025. Please include "Columbine Competitor Scholarship" in the subject line of your email.

#### Selection

Scholarships will be awarded once a year through a competitive process based on:

- academics
- extracurricular activities and leadership
- essay

# The Denver Foundation: Never Forgotten Scholarship (CLOSED FOR 2024-25)

The Never Forgotten Fund was established in 2001 by iHeartMedia, Inc. (formerly Clear Channel) at The Denver Foundation to honor the lives of the 13 victims at Columbine High School on April 20, 1999. Twelve students and one teacher died that day. The contributions they would have made to the world were lost as well. It is hoped that the recipients of this scholarship will carry on the legacy of these individuals by making a positive and lasting impact in the world.

This scholarship typically awards \$5,000. Applications close 2/28/2025.

#### **Eligibility**

Be graduating from a Denver Metropolitan area high school during the current academic year

- Be a U.S. citizen or a permanent legal resident
- Have a cumulative G.P.A. (unweighted) of at least a 3.0
- Have a strong record of school and community involvement
- Be planning to attend an accredited college or university full-time for the upcoming academic year

#### Selection

Scholarships will be awarded once a year through a competitive process based on:

- their commitment to community service
- engagement in their school and/or larger communities
- demonstrated leadership skills
