Grading Criteria:

A	100%	Student <i>nearly always</i> displays the following habits
B	92%	Student <i>regularly</i> displays the following habits
C	84%	Student <i>does not consistently</i> display the following habits
D	76%	Student <i>rarely</i> displays the following habits
