Do you have an incoming kindergarten student, or know someone who does?

To start kindergarten in the 2024-25 school year, your child must turn 5 on or before September 1, 2024. If your child does not meet the new cutoff date, you will need to submit a written request to cboord@hamden.org and your child will have to be assessed to see if kindergarten would be developmentally appropriate.
