

HOW TO USE BITMOJI IN SCHOOL


Get the Mobile App

First, you will need to get the Bitmoji mobile app on your personal device. You will need to create an account with an email. It does not and probably should not be your school email. I use my personal Gmail. Once you go through the setup and choose your Bitmoji features, you can move on to setting up the Bitmoji extension in your BASD Chrome Account.




Setting Up the Bitmoji Extension for Chrome

Click on Apps in the top left side of your chrome browser window and find the chrome web store.




Open the Chrome Web Store and search for <u>Bitmoji</u> to find the <u>Bitmoji</u> extension.Click the blue "Add to Chrome" button. Mine says "Rate it" because I already have it.



Once it is added to your browser, open it


by clicking on it. You will need to sign in with whatever email you used to get

Bitmoji on your mobile device. Sign in.



How to Use the Bitmoji Extension


Click on the Bitmoji Extension now located on your browser window. Search for the Bitmoji you want. Right-click (Control-Click) on the Bitmoji and choose Save Image As from the menu. COPY IMAGE ADDRESS IS EVEN EASIER!




IF YOU SAVE IMAGE (IF YOU COPY IMAGE ADDRESS, SKIP THIS)

Make sure the format is **PNG image** so that you will have a **transparent background**. It will save to your computer and you will be able to just drag it into any google doc, slide or draw. I have even used my Bitmoji in WeVideo with Greenscreen!

You can rename it in the Save As window.



Here is an example of my Bitmoji on the title page of a google slide presentation I created.
