Changes to student schedules impact many other courses and, therefore, will only be made on a limited basis. Schedule changes impact students' individual schedules, the class size of the course into which he/she is transferring, the number of sections per department, and the number of teachers in each department, depending on students' February course selections. Prior to the start of a term, students may only make a change to their schedule for the reasons listed below. If a student meets the acceptable criteria **AND/OR** the change does not create an imbalance, a change can be made. Students must have at least three credit bearing classes on their schedule, per term, to be a full time student at BCHS. Students may drop down from AP/Honors or move up to an Honors level class with teacher approval during the **first 5 days of the course** and only if an available seat exists in the other course. Students may drop any course for a study hall **within the first three weeks of the course** (six weeks for alternating day courses) provided they do not already have a study hall in that term.

When reporting an absence, please provide the student's name and reason for the absence. If they are missing school due to illness, it will be important to let us know ALL of your child's symptoms and any physician confirmed diagnosis such as COVID-19. It will also be important to know if your child is staying home because they have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

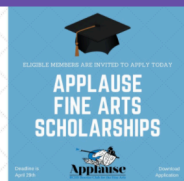
