

Planning: Community Garden Leader Checklist and Garden Chart

Using your Seed Team's "[Sow What?](#)" evaluations and the planting charts below, work with your Seed Team to decide on the following:

- A team name
- The sixteen plants your team will plant, one per plot within your garden:
 - **Requirements for each plant bed:**
 - Each person on your team is responsible for a certain amount of plots. Divide your 16 plots amongst your teammates evenly. Each person should write their name on the plant cards they choose for their plots. These are the little square cards that have been printed and cut up ahead of time. you can find them at the Quest Materials Area.
 - You must research which plants are complementary to others on the list so you can plan their exact location in your bed. Complementary means that they live well next to each other. Each plant will have its own plot within your plant bed, but you want to plant complementary plants in plots next to each other.
 - **Plant bed constraints (the more diversity the better):**
 - 5–10 vegetables (green cards)
 - 3–6 herbs (blue cards)
 - At least 3 flowers (pink cards)
