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The EHBEA Committee is calling for nominations for the **EHBEA Excellence in Public Communication Award**. The prize will be Euro1000, and paid registration and travel expenses (within reason) at the next EHBEA annual conference. The application process is through self-nomination. Co-applicants may apply together, but please note that the monetary value of the award will not exceed that required for one individual's conference registration and travel expenses (co-applicants may split these expenses or nominate one individual to attend the conference, as they prefer).

EHBEA is an interdisciplinary society that supports the activities of researchers with an interest in evolutionary accounts of human cognition, behaviour and society. EHBEA aims to support work with a broad, pluralistic and interdisciplinary perspective. EHBEA encourages rigorous and ethical science, with strong theoretical foundations and integration across disciplines. EHBEA is keen to reward members who engage effectively with audiences outside academia, who may include the general public, policy-makers and other stakeholders. The Excellence in Public Communication Award-winner will be an EHBEA member who promotes its aims to non-academic audiences.

Eligibility: The basis for the award is evidence of excellence in public communication involving research within EHBEA's remit. Applicants can be at any career stage, including postgraduate students.

Nomination procedure: Applicants must self-nominate. By the closing data, the applicant must provide:

1. A copy of this self-nomination form, which includes a description of their public engagement activities (no more than 1,000 words).
2. Evidence of public engagement activities, which may include (but are not limited to): links to blogposts, podcasts, YouTube channels, social media accounts, book webpages (please include book pdf).
3. A CV detailing employment, education, service, publications and conference presentations and talks.
