Compensation is available for 30 faculty and consists of a \$500 taxable payment. Each workshop will be offered again in Spring 2021 (twice) to allow for as much flexibility as possible. Priority will be given based on impact on students and those faculty who did not attend the Go Virtual Summer Institute. If you have already completed the QLT program, you are not eligible for compensation.

Faculty selected for compensation will have a chance to work with a faculty mentor and an instructional technology consultant.

Requirement for compensation:

1. Attend 5 QLT workshops between Fall 2020 and Spring 2021
2. Complete all deliverables associated with each workshop
3. Complete a final course review

These requirements will have to be completed by May 31st, 2021.
