What is a Creator?

Creators generate new ideas and/or build on existing ones by asking questions, thinking flexibly, and learning from experimentation, which leads to innovative approaches and solutions to authentic challenging problems.

Why Creating?

Creativity empowers learners to express one's self, take risks, generate and connect ideas in order to have a lasting impact on society.

How to be a Creator?

Creator Criteria	Learner Behaviors
Generate Ideas	● Engage in inquiry to explore ideas that address/align with the goal or authentic challenging problem ● Identify, evaluate, and synthesize reliable sources to develop workable and innovative ideas
Evaluate Ideas	● Be aware of personal biases ● Use multiple perspectives to process and evaluate ideas
Engage in the Process	● Create a plan that identifies necessary actions and individuals, a timeline, and accountability measures for success ● Take risks by thinking flexibly and learning from experimentation ● Develop a process for the specific task
Design Solution or Product	● Brainstorm and execute innovative solutions either individually or collaboratively ● Utilize a variety of methods to design a solution or product
Feedback, Reflection, and Revision	● Provide and receive feedback in ways that advance the ability to produce high-quality work ● Reflect and revise work continuously
