- Must maintain satisfactory citizenship grades. Any "U" could result in temporary probation and/or permanent suspension after review by Mrs. Davis.
- Must exemplify the essential elements of Character: Trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and good citizenship.
- Maintain excellent school attendance
- Regularly attend the class council meetings
- Carry out duties assigned
- Abide by all school regulations and policies

Student Council officers failing to meet either academic or participation requirements will be placed on probation. If the deficiency is not then cleared in the space of two weeks, the officer in question may be removed from office.
