P7 Hoodies - Academic Year 24/25

The Parent Council have been informed that the scheduled annual residential trip will take place in Arran during September 2024. As a result, hoodies for all current P6 have been sized & ordered ready to ensure these are ready for them to take away during the trip. In previous years the Parent Council has always gifted these to the children, and it was agreed in discussion it would be nice to continue this tradition.

Summer School Disco - 26/6/24

First of all the DATE CHANGE was noted from 19/6 to 26/6 due to hall issues making space unavailable for use. The rest of discussion was centred around requirements needed to host the event and is detailed in actions below. Infant disco has a number of volunteers who have voiced willingness to help supervise/be present, as well as various parent council members offer to help. Also, it was brought to our attention during the discussion that a concerned parent has been in contact regarding whether the use of mobile phones during the event would be allowed. It was felt as a parent council we do not have authority to ban/prevent children from bringing or using such

devices, as many use these under the authorisation from their own caregivers especially outwith of school hours for safety purposes (e.g. keeping in contact when travelling to & from locations), as well as personal reasons (e.g. capturing photos/memories with peers/friends). The parent council do not have authority to challenge, nor deem it appropriate to do so with choices made by individuals in these circumstances. It was however noted that malicious or inappropriate usage of such devices would be deemed unacceptable within the event, and those present would be mindful of this factor. On such an occasion arising there would be a follow up meeting required with all parties involved to discuss.

AGM

A date was required to be set in order to hold the annual AGM meeting. It was discussed that due to summer fun day happening on 30/8/24 following week may be too soon. Date decided upon **Tuesday 10th September 2024**.

Summer Fun Day - 30/8/24

This was based around what we require to be booked/organised to have the date secured; finer details can be discussed/confirmed upon return in August. It was felt keeping this a **FREE** event (donations if parents would like to contribute towards) would encourage families to come along and participate. Current thoughts on food would be basic BBQ: hot dogs, burgers & chips for all, with drink refreshments available also. The idea of providing some small entertainment for children e.g. bouncy castle, games etc. was considered a good incentive for parents, and helps keep children occupied.
