Minutes of the QCGC Board Meeting of March 12, 2025

Secretary's Report: It was moved, seconded and approved to accept the minutes of the February 12, 2025 meeting as written.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Margie Barber presented the report as of February 28, 2025. Total revenues to date were \$475 in 2025 dues with no expenses, resulting in a bank balance of \$2,082.50. It was moved, seconded and approved to accept the Treasurer's Reports as submitted.

Communications: Given Dick Sussman's health status, Susan Lafo has established a new website with all relevant information from the previous website carried over to the new one. Janine Baxter will submit information for What's Happening on the Quail Creek website.

Soldiers, and cemetery rubbings. The Program Committee will also be meeting with new member Patrice Hartman concerning a program idea she has.

She also reported that 2026 room requests have been submitted to Quail Creek Member Services.

The Program Committee requested that a designated amount annually be set aside for speakers so that money could be obligated to speakers prior to approval by the Board. Bobbi reported that they lost a paid speaker because she could not immediately commit to a fee. She moved that the designated amount for speakers be no less than \$400 a year. Her motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
