General Information:

- Doors will open at 7:45 pm.
- No one will be allowed in after 9 pm.
- Parents will be called after 9 pm, if the student has not arrived.
- No one is allowed to leave before 10 pm.
- Prom Queen and King will be announced at 10 pm.
- Snacks and drinks will be served.

Class Fees:

- All of your class fees must be current before you can purchase a prom ticket.
- Freshman, Sophomore and Junior class fees are \$25 per year, and Senior class fees are \$35.
- Class fees can be paid online through My School Bucks or by cash or check in the commons, during lunch, March 24th through April 2nd. Please make checks out to China Spring High School.

Drug Testing:

- All China Spring students attending Prom must be signed up for the drug testing program. Forms can be found in the front office.

FAFSA:

- All Seniors must submit a FAFSA confirmation email or opt out form, to the Counseling Center, to be eligible to purchase a Prom ticket.

Guests:

- All guests must be currently enrolled high school students or not be older than 19 years of age.
- Guests that are not China Spring High School students, must complete and submit a guest application and be approved by CSHS administration, prior to purchasing a ticket.
- Guest applications can be found in the front office.
- All guests that are not China Spring High School students must bring current photo identification, to be checked before going into Prom.
- Guests without current photo identification will not be admitted into Prom.

Ticket Purchasing Process:

1. Students have from March 23rd to April 2nd to complete all items on the Prom Attendance Checklist (class fees, drug testing form, FAFSA for all seniors, prom information page).
2. Turn in the completed Prom Attendance Checklist, with the Prom information page completed, to the front office.
3. Submitted forms will be verified by CSHS staff.
4. Once approved, the student will receive a Prom Ticket Code # paper with a code to be used at hometownticketing.com.
5. Hometown Ticketing will issue a QR code "ticket." Students will use this QR code to check in the night of Prom. Prom tickets may be purchased after April 2nd.

Ticket Details:

- Tickets may only be purchased online. Tickets will NOT be sold at school.
- Tickets are \$30 each, from April 3rd until April 17th.
- Beginning April 18th, tickets will be \$40 each.

Dress Code:

- Girls may wear semi-formal gowns, formal gowns, or outfits with pants. Strapless and spaghetti straps will be permitted. Dresses should be modestly cut, no plunging necklines.
- Boys may wear a suit or sport coat. At a minimum, boys are expected to wear semi-formal wear, such as slacks, nice shoes, and a nice shirt (ties are encouraged, but not required).
- ALL students and guests....visible tattoos will not be allowed.
- Blue jeans will not be allowed.

-If the attire is questionable, students are encouraged to show their evening wear to CSHS administration beforehand to determine if it is Prom appropriate.

-Students and guests who are non-compliant with the dress code will be given an opportunity to comply with the aforementioned policy. If the student or guest refuses to comply, he or she will not be permitted to attend Prom. Ticket costs will not be refunded.
