50 mins	Principal Report Dress Code Technology Contract Mill Levy and Bond	 Christopher Zimmerman informed members the new dress code policy was well received by students and parents. Mr. Zimmerman reminded the committee per the policy if a student receives a dress code violation administration calls parents to make them aware. Committee members discussed the new technology contract which includes a new rule where students are not allowed to use technology device during school hours unless a staff member allows them to use it as an educational tool. If the student asks a staff member for permission students may use their device to contact parents in the designated pod during lunch. If students are caught utilizing their technology device without special permission, the device will be confiscated and brought to the office until the end of the school day.
