# Wootenstien's Document of all things commission

### **Important**

- An interested commissioner is ULTIMATELY REQUIRED to read this. If one doesn't, the artist, aka me, isn't liable if any terms not followed or noted end up with a commission being terminated or not started at all
- I do this for fun, practice, and meeting new people not for money. So although money is involved, it is not a determining factor for me to initiate or continue a commission. So to be blunt, don't think you own me just because you're paying me
- By commissioning me you are agreeing to everything stated within this document and my commissioning page on FA

### What I will draw

Although the list of things I would be willing to draw would be quite long indeed, here are some things that I do enjoy drawing, or are (In my opinion) uncommon in comparison to what other artists offer

- Macro/Micro
- Paws/hooves/talons/claws/Feet/etc
- Ferals
- Destruction
- Perspective shots
- Watersport
- Both Male and Female characters
- Vore, mouth, privates, etc
- Established characters<sup>1</sup>

## What I will NOT draw

- NSFW kids, NSFW is up for interpretation of myself
- Scat
- Uberfat/UberMuscle (Although regular fat and muscle is fine~)
- Heavy gore<sup>2</sup>
- Female Privates, Breasts however are fine
- Hyper bodyparts (Perhaps rarely but most likely no)
- Human-looking feet on anthros. It's not my thing

- Reference sheets
- Comics

<sup>1</sup>I will draw animated, or otherwise already existing characters, may it be from TV shows, Cartoons, games, etc. However, characters used as a reference will be within my own style and may not be a 100% recreation of said character

<sup>2</sup> Heavy gore can include large amounts of blood, internal organs, or anything I deem too much for my current tastes

## Do's and Don'ts

#### DO's

- **Know what you want!** Although I'm here to help you figure things out in terms of smaller details, angles, or give ideas and input, I am not going to sit here and discuss what you want when you don't even know. So, if it seems like you don't know what you desire by the time the commission is to start, I will most likely not take it, for my own sanity.
- Send me anything in terms of reference and what you wish for me to take away from it! Not doing so may result in changes not desired and I will not "fix" the m past a certainpoint depending on how far along I am or how complicated the change is. This brings me to the next one...
- Ask for updates! But don't abuse this. If you don't ask, I will not, after the
  composition sketch and its subsequent sketch send you updates unless I am
  confused and require your input. And I am not liable to fix anything that the
  commission deems unsatisfactory due to their lack of requests in updates or
  requirements given to the artist.
- Post your commission! All commissions created by me, with my artist signature included, can be added to any website/gallery by the commissioner exclusively for free viewership to all individuals within said website/gallery.

Request to watch your commission live! I love streaming for people
and if you want to be intimately involved, I can draw your commission live!
However, it sadly has to be on my time, although I'll try to work with you on that~

#### **DON'TS**

- Commission me unless you're 18 years of age or older! For my protection, I will not be taking any commissions from individuals under this age. By commissioning me you are agreeing to be of age
- **Sell your commission!** Although you may post your drawings to any site you wish, you are not allowed to sell said drawings, may it be as physical prints, bodywear, etc without the sole consideration and request of the artist, aka me. This does include a Patreon, even if it is "free"
- Paying another artist to alter or copy a commission Although you can color it yourself, paying for another artist to color, shade, alter lines, trace ect, is not allowed. This also includes any compositional sketch that was not picked.
- Add any comments to invoices on PayPal To avoid a headache just leave the invoice blank. Not doing so will result in the possible termination to any future commissions taken place between us.
- Post any WIPs without informing me first. Don't get me wrong, I love it when people post their WIPs! It means they're excited. But if you plan on posting them, please tell me so I may give you at least a cleaned-up version (for example, without artistic notes)

### **Prices**

#### **Base Prices**

- All base prices are located on my FA page https://www.furaffinity.net/commissions/wootenstien/
- All drawings come with 2 characters in their base price
- Busts (half of a character) and icons are half the base price

#### **Additionals**

- Backgrounds are +half base price to +Full Base price
  - Basic backgrounds such as a simple room, easy, non-destroyed landscape, low detail, etc will be closer to half the base price
  - Complex backgrounds, which include buildings, crowds of individuals, crazy perspectives, destruction, and high levels of detail will be closer to the full base price
- Additional characters after 2 are +half base price
  - My own characters, however, or characters I may find interesting in drawing, will reduce the price to +1/4th the base price
  - Low-detailed crowds coincide with backgrounds not characters
- Inserts are between 1/3rd 1/2 base price
  - Can only contain a simple background
- I'M NOT CURRENTLY OFFERING THIS Subsequential images (Images that are highly similar and follow a theme) reduce the price by ¼. As in it reduces the total price by 25 percent, NOT making the picture ¼ the original cost
  - Very small changes, such as a simple dressing change reduce the base price TO ¼ - ½ the original cost
    - For example, clothes to naked, changes to paws, ect, or up to my interpretation

### **Normal Commission Process**

- Once an individual has been selected for a commission, the commissioner can expect some sort of contact, may it be through notes on FA or email (If supplied and requested) within the first few days of selection
- 2. Once a return note containing the commissioner's preferred mode of contact has been received, information using said contact information will be exchanged
- 3. After an idea has been determined, and the quality has been chosen, a minimum of the base price is to be sent over to the artist. If this option is chosen, let it be known that any sequential payments through PayPal will take account of their tax, aka, the commissioner pays more
  - a. However, a commissioner is allowed to send over the total cost of the commission which means that PayPal's tax will not be added to the total cost. But, this also means that they are theoretically locked to a certain quality. Unless of course, another payment is made
  - b. If the full price of the piece is not sent over, I am obligated to not show updates on pieces or heavily watermarked updates for portions that have not been paid for yet.
    - An example of this includes paying for the price of just shading with no background, however, a background for the piece has been made and is planned to be paid for
  - c. IMPORTANT NOTE: The price of said commission may be adjusted throughout the entire process, depending on any quality changes made, additions, removals, etc
- 4. Once payment has been received, Composite sketch(s) will be made, to which the commissioner can choose any of them and make any desired changes they wish for, may it be angle, character position, background (if applicable) etc
  - a. Composite sketches more focus on angle, composition, body placement, and scenery, things such as expression, body sizes, etc will be done on the secondary sketch
  - b. However, If it seems as though ideas are drastically being changed with each iteration, an additional cost may be requested to cover the amount of time taken for your idea. Aka, be prepared, it will help you (and your wallet) in the end

- After a composite sketch has been chosen. A secondary sketch will be made and sent to the commissioner. Feel free to make any smaller changes or desires you want to the sketch.
- 6. Once a secondary sketch has been okayed, any subsequent updates will be down to the commissioner to request, unless clarification is required. Line art, coloration, and shading will be completed in a timely manner and hopefully completed within a short time span. Although my own work may be completed in conjunction with the commissioners
- 7. Once the drawing has been completed and if payment for the piece of artwork has not been finalized, the commissioner will send over the remaining balance to which the artist will then send the final, completed piece. Any small changes from the commissioner are allowed and even recommended, because after a commissioner is deemed happy, business between said commissioner and artist will have been concluded.

## **Quick Pic Process**

Most of the info regarding this is on my <u>Commission Info</u> over on FA However the process more or less goes like this~

- I will draw whatever you want within the bounds of my terms of service for up to 4/5 hours.
  - The 5th hour is typically reserved for pictures that I'm absolutely having a blast with and/or I feel as though the 5th hour would enhance the picture's quality considerably. Note: I will always ask you if you want me to continue before I do so
- Once we decide, you pay me the amount we settle upon
- I'll stream for you on discord (Or other locations possibly) and at any location, you desire on the platform! (such as a server or private chat) Bring who you want! For example:
  - just you, your friends, my friends(?), heck have me as an on-site artist on your server for a discord gathering you're having, whatever (let's make it a party! :D)

- Expect me to voice with you, but if you want, feel free to keep yourself muted, I
  probably won't mute myself so it's easier to ask you questions about the pic, etc
- You can tell me to stop drawing a picture at any time, change things, add characters, talk about your favorite cheese, have me make a horrible joke, etc.

When we finish, you'll receive your picture, and (hopefully) we'll all have a good time!

## **Terms & Conditions**

- I retain the right to refuse or accept any pieces of artwork that may or may not be in terms with what I allow and disallow within this document or any consecutive page/website/etc. And to said ideas, I may or may not offer an alternative or compromise to which the commissioner may accept or deny.
- To protect myself from legal matters, I will not be taking commissions from minors. By commissioning me you are agreeing to be at least 18 years of age or older.
- I reserve the right to commence a refund at any point of a commission, due to lack of communication, rude or irritable behavior, or anything I deem worthy of such an action. If a refund has been deemed necessary, the commissioner will receive a payment in proportion to the amount of work that has been already completed, which also may or may not include the art commissioned for
- All images created by me are granted to me by US Copyright law and to which I
  can post said images to any gallery or website I may own, although if possible,
  credit towards the commissioner will take place
- All drawings of established characters are owned by their respective intellectual properties/companies, I am in no way regarding said characters as my own creation.
- Commissions may be done in and out of order, and my own works may be finished in between commissions.
- I reserve the right to disallow the inclusion of a single character within multiple commissions during a single or multiple (up to 2) commission cycles.
- The artist retains the right to make any stylized changes, and additions if not expressed by the commissioner
- I as the artist, am allowed to stream, record, and show works commissioned, unless specifically stated by the commissioner and both parties are in agreement
