

∆ in the carotid pulse and their dDx


Anacrotic pulse

slow initial upstroke; the peak is close to S2 fixed left ventricular outflow obstruction (aortic stenosis)




Pulsus bisferiens percussion and tidal waves occurring during systole.

hemodynamically significant aortic regurgitation or combined aortic stenosis and regurgitation with dominant regurgitation.
