Thank you for writing to us with your inquiries.

It is difficult to find housing providers that can meet the stipulations for both parole and Strict and Intensive Supervision and Treatment (SIST) for people on the sex offender registry. Consequently, organizations such as The Fortune Society and the Center for Urban Community Services face challenging obstacles in connecting such individuals with housing providers. While these organizations do work with people on the sex offender registry, each individual is evaluated on a case-by-case basis and successful placement in supportive housing takes time and is limited at best. For these reasons, if you are looking for housing immediately upon re-entry, we recommend going directly to 30th Street Intake.

30th Street Intake is New York City's public assessment shelter providing single homeless men ages 18+ with free screening, assessment, and temporary emergency housing. 30th Street offers special assistance for veterans and provides services to all individuals, regardless of immigration status. 30th Street is open 24 hours a day, including weekends and holidays.
