- Many use cases and organizations/consortia/service providers make prioritization of features difficult
  - Does jspui need to be considered further based on the install base, with only 2 leaders?
- Are people going to go into production with 7.0 or wait for perhaps 7.2? Which also calls into question the level of effort for this analysis (2 of the 5 people were waiting for 7.2).
  - Which features make sense to bundle from a development perspective (Question for Steering)
  - New DSpace users might accept that some features are "missing." Coming from bepress or other new installations.
    - Prioritize basic workflow for new DSpace users. Would someone implementing now take the risk to implement 7.x?

- What criteria did you use for voting and ranking features?
  - New items prioritized lower or removed (except accessibility)
  - o Asked the people who work with DSpace day to day
  - User-centred view (what if that feature was not there?)
