Please send what you can

Writing and drawing

- ☐ 24 pencils (#2, sharpened if possible)
- ☐ 1 large eraser or a pack of pencil-top erasers
- ☐ 1 pack of colored pencils (12 or 24 count)
- ☐ 1 pack of thin markers
- ☐ 2 highlighters, any colors
- ☐ 1 pack of black or blue pens (5th grade especially — for editing their own work)

Paper and organizing

- ☐ 3 wide-ruled composition notebooks
- ☐ 1 pack of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper
- ☐ 4 pocket folders with prongs (any colors)
- ☐ 1 three-ring binder, 1 inch
- ☐ 1 pack of sticky notes (we use these constantly for reading)

Tools

- ☐ 1 pair of scissors
- ☐ 2 glue sticks
- ☐ 1 12-inch ruler with inches and centimeters
- ☐ 1 pencil pouch or box
- ☐ 1 pair of headphones or earbuds, labeled with your student's name

Headphones stay at school all year. Simple wired ones work best — they are easier to replace and do not need charging.

For the whole class (if you are able)

- ☐ 1 box of tissues
- ☐ 1 container of disinfecting wipes

- ☐ 1 pack of dry-erase markers
- ☐ 1 ream of copy paper or a pack of cardstock

These are shared, not assigned. They keep our room running and no student's name goes on them.

Comes with them every day

- ☐ A water bottle they can refill
- ☐ Rain gear — a jacket with a hood and boots they can move in. We go outside in Southeast weather.
- ☐ A backpack big enough for a folder and a library book

Recess and outdoor learning happen in rain. Dry feet make for a better day.
