

## The Sound of Music!

We all love music, right?

But noise levels can be an issue, which means that we need to be very much aware of the noise that we put out. Remember: even if you get super excited about your playlist, it does not mean that all fellow burners will share your experience. Contrary to visuals where one could close eyes or simply step away, it's not possible to shut down the acoustic perception!

So, we have to have establish some rules:

1. Leave your bluetooth speakers at home!
2. Ok, you brought your bluetooth speaker because you did not understand the previous rule. Well, we will not do security checks as you enter the burn. So if you want to transform the room that you will share with others into a party zone make sure it happens with 100% consent and don't forget thy neighbours.
3. If your dream needs music make sure you coordinate with soundlead and check out the sound-level-map as well. Soundlead will measure decibels and help you place your equipment.
4. We will have dedicated areas where we will have PA systems for everybody to use, but you will have to sign up and coordinate with soundlead. Timetable will be online and editable for all. Please, **NO** popup parties in the middle of the night or when a workshop next door needs silence!
5. Get fucking consent! Not everybody will love the music you like. The principle of consent applies to sound as well! Littering the environment with noise/sound/music is a consent violation.

There will be no noise police in the first place because we all know that burners are sensitive, hyperintelligent, pandimensional beings. We will however have Rangers who will remind you to turn down the volume should it be necessary. Please follow their *advice*!

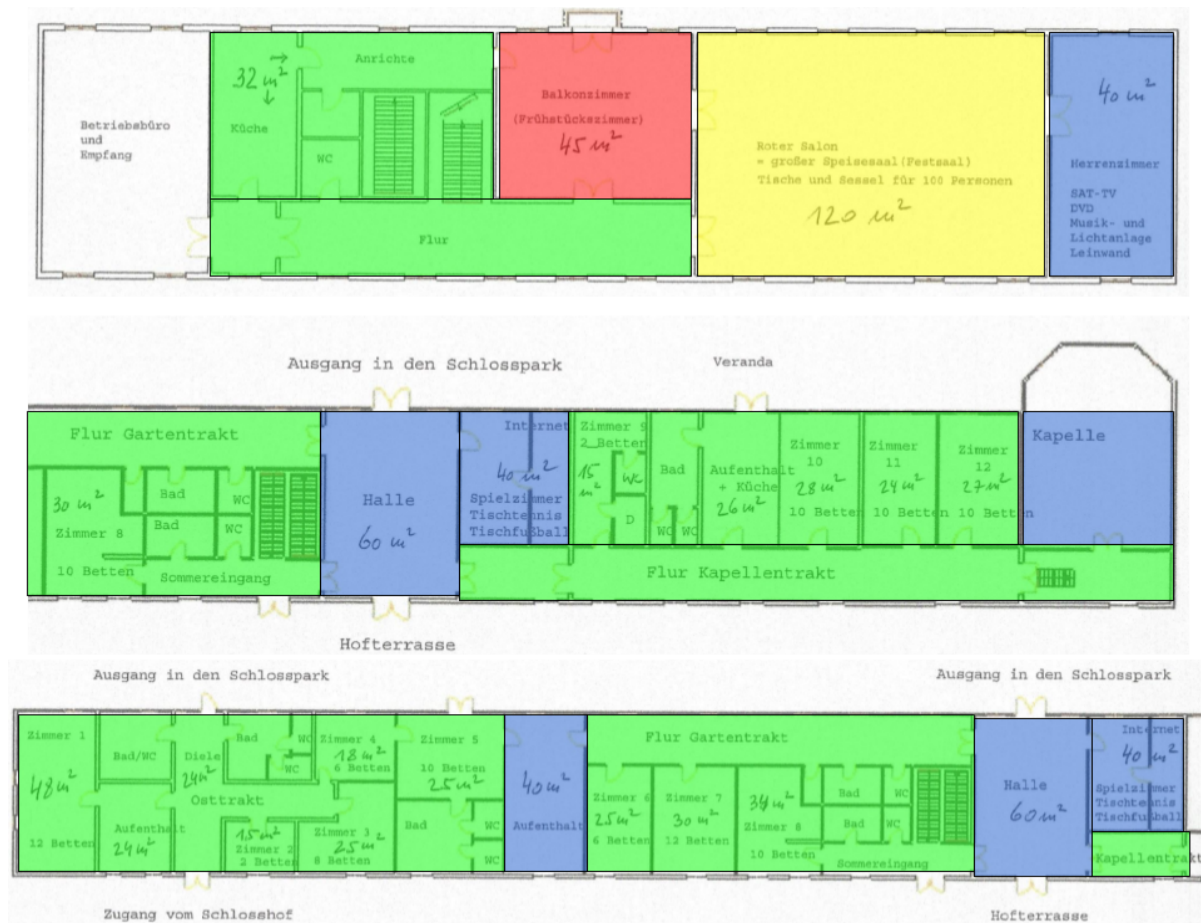

### No rule without exception!

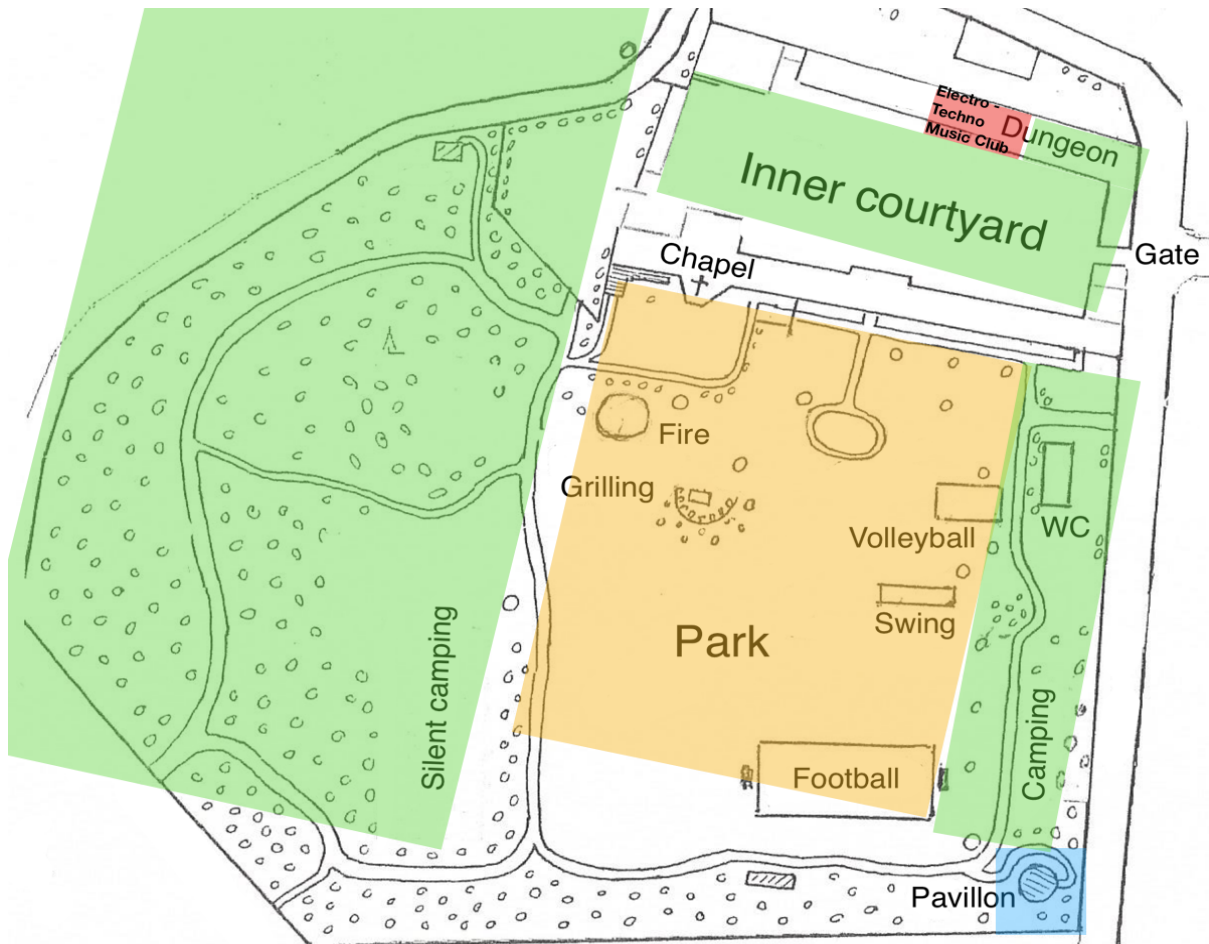
If you plan to organize a brass band parade across the whole place, amplify your moans, or offer other mind and/or ear blowing events, sign up to the dreams platform to let us know and we will find a timeslot for it!

- **Green** - Silent – NO electronic music!
- **Blue** - Small speakers at dedicated times only or workshops. *Silent: 1 am - 10 am!*
- **Red** - Big sound systems. Levels will be controlled by loudness metering.
- **Yellow** - We will have to check – but *no party 1 am - 10 am!*
