

Robert Byrnes Dies at 63; Longtime Bank Executive

Robert L. Byrnes of 211 Newington Road, West Hartford, an assistant treasurer of the East Hartford branch of the Connecticut Bank & Trust Co., died Monday at Hartford Hospital. He was 63.

Byrnes was employed by the bank 23 years. He was an assistant treasurer the last 13 years.

He was an Air Force veteran of the Korean War and a member of Hayes-Velhage Post 96, West Hartford. He also was a member of the Church of St. Brigid, West Hartford, and the Knights of Columbus of Newington.
