O2 ADMINISTRATION COURSE

This course is intended to teach emergency oxygen (O₂) administration. This program covers equipment and procedures for administering oxygen as an emergency procedure. Equipment selection and use for decompression illness emergencies are detailed with practical components to train a well rounded rescuer.



Who this course is for:

- Scuba Divers
- Dive Professionals and boat staff
- Other individuals who may need to administer oxygen

Course prerequisites

- Minimum age 18, 10 with parental consent

What you can expect to learn:

The Oxygen Administration program is designed to train layperson rescuers for:

- Identification of DCI
- administration of emergency oxygen

- Recognize and evaluate an emergency and a victim
- Know how to activate or alert the emergency medical services (EMS)
- Be able to administer O₂ to a breathing or non-breathing person
