- Started working for Oracle as a part-time intern while I was still going through college. For the Oracle Business Process Management team (explain the product)
- 2. My first role was in the back-end team. We were in charge of:
 - a. Project persistence
 - b. Project collaboration
 - c. Security
- 3. Once my internship was over I was offered a full-time position in the same team. I grew in the role from intern to junior and then senior dev. Some of the challenges during this phase were:
 - a. distributed VCS in-house solution based on SVN (see patents).
 - b. Improved project loading performance by 5x.
 - c. Implemented the edition lifecycle and project collaboration between web and native applications.
- 4. On 2014 I was the first member of my team to be relocated in the US. I served as contact point with other teams already in the US and with my bosses boss.
