If a nomination is not chosen for three (3) years (initial year plus two [2] subsequent years), the nominator will be notified that the nomination was unsuccessful and can be resubmitted after a waiting period of three (3) years. A nomination may only be considered for three (3) years in any six (6) year period.

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PART C – Complete for Athlete

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

An “athlete” shall be deemed to be a person, living or deceased, who has demonstrated character, sportsmanship and integrity as well as outstanding ability in his/her particular activity, having brought honour to themselves and Moose Jaw and District. Athletes nominated for this category must have been retired from active participation beyond the provincial level in the sport(s) for which he or she has been nominated for a minimum of three (3) years. An athlete that has reached his/her fiftieth (50th) birthday may be eligible for nomination without any waiting period whether or not they are still active as a competitor. The nominee must have been a Moose Jaw native or an individual with substantial connections to Moose Jaw and District or a resident during the period for which the outstanding performance is claimed.

ATHLETE NOMINATION CHECK LIST

Note: SHSAA/ Minor aged individuals are not eligible for induction.

- ☐ Athletes must be of junior age classification or university level, or higher, to be eligible. Regardless of age, if an individual competes in an open competition the nomination will be considered for recognition.

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PART D – Complete for Builder

BUILDER ELIGIBILITY

A “builder” shall be a person, living or deceased, whose service, other than that of an athlete, has made an exceptional contribution to a particular sport or sports. The term “builder” illustrates a variety of functions including: coach, official, administrator, volunteer, media and sports medicine whose work for sports over an extended period of time has been outstanding having brought honour to themselves and Moose Jaw and District. The nominee must have been a Moose Jaw native or an individual with substantial connections to Moose Jaw and District or a resident during the period for which the outstanding performance is claimed.

BUILDER NOMINATION CHECK LIST

- ☐ Meets the residency requirements as listed above.
- ☐ Developed his/her skill level to a Provincial, National or International standard while a permanent resident of Moose Jaw and District, but may also have gone elsewhere during their career and achieved greatness.
- ☐ OR, the nominee has served to develop sport in such a way as to make their contributions of an outstanding nature at the Local/Grass Roots level to bring great credit to the sport and high respect for the individual.
- ☐ He/she directs athletes in a leadership capacity.
- ☐ One, or more, of the following: coach, official, administrator, volunteer, media and sports medicine.
- ☐ Recognized for his/her outstanding effort in one or more sports, normally for at least ten (10) years, but not necessarily consecutive.
- ☐ List of contributions to amateur sport in Moose Jaw and District.
- ☐ Completed the Nomination Form. (include parts A,B,D,F,G)

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PART E – Complete for Team

ELIGIBILITY

A “team” shall be deemed to be two or more people, living or deceased, who together have won a Provincial, Regional, National, Olympic or World Championship. Special consideration will be given to local teams who have reached the maximum level of excellence in their field with no competition beyond the District having brought honour to themselves and Moose Jaw and District. Teams nominated for this category must wait three (3) years before they are eligible for induction. The team must be based in Moose Jaw and District during the period for which the outstanding performance is claimed.

NOMINATION CHECK LIST

Note: SHSAA/ Minor aged teams are not eligible for induction.

- ☐ Meets the residency requirements as listed above.
- ☐ Developed their skill level to a Provincial, National or International standard while a permanent resident of Moose Jaw and District, but may also have gone elsewhere during their career and achieved greatness.
- ☐ 75% of the same team members over the period evaluated.
- ☐ 75% of the team members must have been comprised of:
 - a) Moose Jaw natives or individuals with a substantial connection to Moose Jaw and District, or
 - b) Residents during the period for which the outstanding performance is claimed.
- ☐ The junior age category or university level will be considered the minimum level of accomplishment for recognition to be considered. Regardless of age, if a team competes in an open competition the nomination will be considered for recognition.
- ☐ List of accomplishments and results at the International level (if applicable).
- ☐ List of accomplishments and results at the National level (if applicable).
- ☐ List of accomplishments and results at the Provincial level.
- ☐ Retired from competition for three (3) years.
